

Gifts, Donations, and Memorial Policy

Abbott Library, Sunapee, NH

Gifts of books, other useful materials, and contributions from individuals or groups which help the Library serve the informational, educational, recreational, and cultural needs of the Town of Sunapee may be accepted; provided that the donation becomes the unconditional property of the Library. The Abbott Library Board of Trustees (the "Board") has the authority to make whatever disposition it deems advisable.

All gifts are accepted in accordance with New Hampshire library statutes.

Donors will be given a statement listing the number and general type of materials donated if they so request. Neither the Library Director nor the Board will make any evaluation of such gifts for tax purposes. The responsibility for such evaluation is entirely a matter for the donor of the gift.

Unrestricted gifts of money, real property and / or stock will be accepted. The Library will accept gifts of money in memory or in tribute to an individual. Gift acknowledgement plates may be included.

Personal property, art objects, antiques, and other museum quality objects will be accepted as gifts at the discretion of the Board and the Art Donation Policy will apply.

Materials not needed, but in good condition and still of value, may be offered to another organization or sold at the Library Book Sale.
