

Wireless Internet Access Policy

Abbott Library, Sunapee, NH

The Library provides public, non-secure Internet access point(s) for users with portable wireless devices such as laptops and mobile devices. The access point(s) will allow users access to the Internet from devices while located within range of the access point.

Reception and connection may vary according to the number of wireless devices in use at any one time.

Library staff will provide general information on the settings necessary to access the Internet via the Library's wireless connection. If a user has problems accessing the Internet over this connection, staff will only verify that the Library's connection is operating normally. Staff will not perform troubleshooting on the patron's own wireless device.

The wireless Internet connection provided by the Library is public and is not secure. Patrons shall not transmit or access any sensitive information whatsoever using the Internet access provided by the Library, and should use the latest anti-virus and anti-malware protection, spyware and other standard protection software to prevent unauthorized access to their own devices while they are in use at the Library.

Wireless users shall not transmit any personal health information or personally identifiable information (including social security number, financial account number, governmental identification number, passwords, and any other sensitive personal information) while using any wireless connection in the Library.

The Library's Wireless Internet Access Policy governs the use of the Internet over the Library's wireless access points in all areas within range of the connection, both inside and outside the building.
